Introductions (All)

DC Smarter Business Challenge Presentation (Scott Pomeroy & MaryLynn Wilhere)

- Intended to take the place of a green business certification
- Website is: <u>www.dcsmarterbusiness.com</u>
- Partnering with AOBA, DCBIA, USGBC-NCR
- ✤ As of 4/3/2013, there were 20 companies, with 92 buildings and 28M square feet participating
- Having different foci for each month—March was the Building Energy Summit
- Mayor's Sustainability Awards to be announced this summer

Green Code Discussion (Bill Updike & Dave Epley)

- Need to think about prepping and education for city council staffers
- Discussion about commissioning, specifically around nonprofit developers (CPDC, National Housing Trust, etc.)
- Discussion about schedule—sending to council this summer simultaneous with second comment period

Green Building Fund (Bill Updike & Dave Epley)

- Question about the nature of the fund—does it have to be spent in FY13 (short answer is yes, but it could go into fund balance for FY14, and DCRA could then ask for additional budget authority in FY14)
- Discussion about the possibility of having a training session for green procurement—bring in Jonathan Rifkin from OCP (and include private sector as well)







Energy Star Benchmarking Discussion (Marshall Duer-Balkind)

- Compliance range is 60-70% (DC probably highest of any city at initial submittal)
- DDOE was sending out warning e-mails for those that didn't comply (have a period of one month to come into compliance)
- Help center got more than 200 calls, and the team conducted weekly trainings and responded to countless e-mails
- ✤ Data for 200,000 SF and greater buildings can be made available this summer
- Worked with PEPCO to provide whole building aggregate data to owners, and about 100-150 buildings took advantage of that
 - Ultimate goal is to have info updated directly to Portfolio Manager
 - Patty recommended that we give PEPCO public credit for this
- Patty asked if we would include waste reporting at some point (not currently part of the Portfolio Manager tool)

Sustainable DC Update (Laine Cidlowski)

- DC government working on internal work plan for these efforts (Mayor's release of implementation plan on April 22)
- Have created a list of lead agencies and contacts for various action items
