

## Energy Benchmarking of Existing Buildings Whole Building Data Confirmation Form

Under the District benchmarking regulation (DC Official Code § 6-1451.03(c), and 20 DCMR 3513), all multifamily buildings over 50,000 square feet are required to report benchmarking data on an annual basis by April 1st. This benchmarking data should include **whole building information**, including any individual residential units.

The purpose of this form is to confirm that accurate whole building data for your calendar year 2015 benchmarking report has been provided. Completion of this form within 5 business days acknowledges that all data included in your calendar year 2015 benchmarking report is accurate and uses whole building data.

Whole building utility data: Data for the total consumption of all energy and water used in the building. This includes owner-paid utility information, tenant or residential usage information, ground-floor retail stores and restaurants, etc. This may be in the form of one central meter or a combination of house and tenant meters.
