SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority - Anacostia River Clean Up and Protection Act of 2009
ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor
By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(6) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code §§ 1-204.22(6) and (11), by the Anacostia River Clean Up and Protection Act of 2009 (the "Act"), effective September 23, 2009 (D.C. Law 18-55; D.C. Official Code § 2-1226.51, et seq.), it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The rulemaking authority vested in the Mayor by § 5(a) of the Act (D.C. Official Code § 2-1226.54(a)), is delegated to:
a. The Director of the District Department of the Environment on all matters in the Act other than any rulemaking authority exclusively delegated by the Mayor to a specific agency in subparagraph b. and c. of this Mayor's Order.
b. The Chief Financial Officer on matters relating to §§ 4(c) and 9(a) of the Act.
c. The Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles on matters relating to $\S \S 8$ and 9(b) of the Act.
2. The Mayor's authority to implement and enforce the Act, with the exception of $\S \S$ 4(b)(1)(A), (C), (D), and (E), which are delegated to the Chief Financial Officer, and §§ 8 and 9(b), which are delegated to the Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles, is delegated to the Director of the District Department of the Environment who may further delegated his or her authority to subordinates under his or her jurisdiction.
3. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Order shall be effective immediately and shall supersede all prior Orders to the extent of any inconsistency.
