The Underground Storage Tank (UST) Management Act of 1990, as amended, and implementing regulations, require that sellers of real property in the District inform prospective purchasers in writing, prior to entering into a contract for sale, of the existence or removal of any USTs of which the seller has knowledge. Sellers of individual condominium or cooperative units are not subject to the disclosure requirements. Sellers of single family homes are required to fill out this form, unless a comparable disclosure provision including a signature line for buyer's acknowledgement is included in the sales contract.
