

RiverSmart Rewards Simple Application Information and Instructions

The Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE) administers the application and verification process for both RiverSmart Rewards (DOEE's Stormwater Fee Discount Program) and DC Water's Clean Rivers (CRIAC) Incentive Program. A person who submits a RiverSmart Rewards Simple Application is requesting a discount under both programs.

Maximum discounts:

- Up to 55% off the Stormwater Fee
- Up to 4% off the Clean Rivers Impervious Area Charge

This Simple Application form is reserved for properties with green infrastructure (GI) that manages stormwater runoff from less than 2,000 square feet of impervious area.* Most RiverSmart Homes participants will qualify to use the Simple Application.

*Note that even a property assessed more than 2,000 square feet of impervious area may still qualify to use this application. For example, a property has 2,500 square feet of impervious area, but its green infrastructure manages stormwater runoff from the 1,500 square foot roof. This property could use the Simple Application form.

The <u>Standard Application</u> is available for properties with green infrastructure managing stormwater runoff from more than 2,000 square feet of impervious area.

- 3. Recent photos of green infrastructure practices described on this application
