

RiverSmart Rewards Simple Application Information and Instructions

The Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE) administers the application and verification process for both RiverSmart Rewards (DOEE's Stormwater Fee Discount Program) and DC Water's Clean Rivers (CRIAC) Incentive Program. A person who submits a RiverSmart Rewards Simple Application is requesting a discount under both programs.

Maximum discounts:

- Up to 55% off the Stormwater Fee
- Up to 20% off the Clean Rivers Impervious Area Charge

This Simple Application form is reserved for properties with green infrastructure (GI) that manages stormwater runoff from less than 2,000 square feet of impervious area.* Most RiverSmart Homes participants will qualify to use the Simple Application.

*Note that even a property assessed more than 2,000 square feet of impervious area may still qualify to use this application. For example, a property has 2,500 square feet of impervious area, but its green infrastructure manages stormwater runoff from the 1,500 square foot roof. This property could use the Simple Application form.

The Standard Application is available for properties with green infrastructure managing stormwater runoff from more than 2,000 square feet of impervious area.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION

1. Renewal Application Form (starts on page 2 of this document)
 - a. DOEE requires submittal of a complete application including pages 2 and 3 of this application
 - b. You must indicate that all practices are or are not still installed, and please list any new installations or removals
 - c. You must sign and date page 3
2. Copy of recent DC Water bill
3. Recent photos of each green infrastructure practice listed in Step 3 of this application
 - a. Pictures must be clear, and the practices must be easily seen. Green infrastructure practices are only effective at reducing stormwater runoff when they are maintained. Providing pictures helps DOEE ensure that the practices installed are in good condition
 - b. Pictures must include the entire practice. Ex:
 - i. For a rain barrel, the downspout and soaker hose must be visible
 - ii. For trees, please submit a picture of the tree and a close up of one leaf. If not seasonally possible, a close up of the bark may be submitted

- Downspouts routed to yard or other landscaped areas

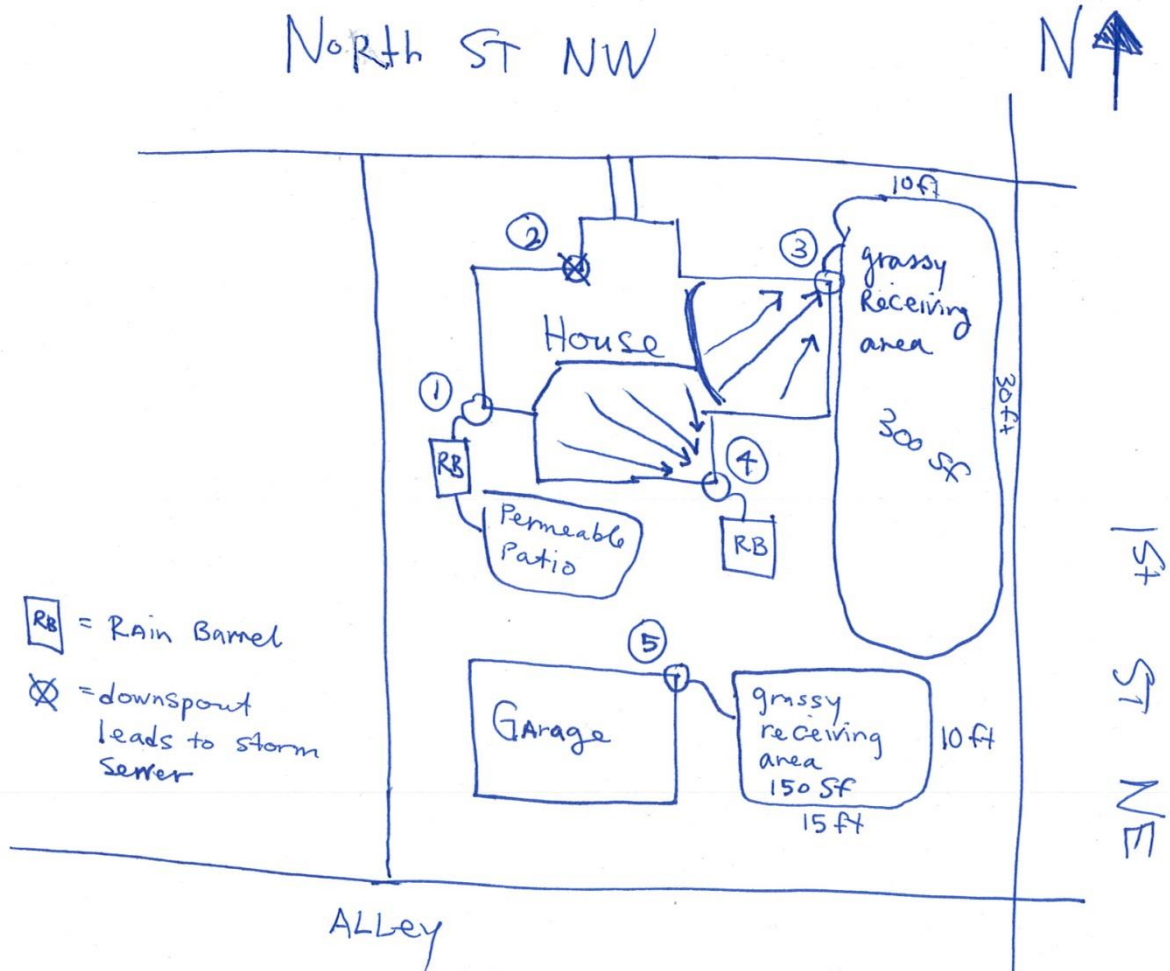

EXAMPLE SITE PLAN

(required for all applications that include downspout disconnections)



Downspouts

- #1 - Drains to Rain Barrel. Rain Barrel overflows to permeable pavement.
- #2 - Drains to storm sewer pipe.
- #3 - Drains to grassy area (300 SF). The roof area is approximately 120 SF.
- #4 - Drains to rain Barrel. Rain Barrel overflows to storm sewer pipe.
- #5 - Drains to grassy receiving area (150 SF). The garage roof is also 150 SF.
