Flood Risk Outreach Campaign –RFA 2018-1906-NRA-01

Q1. Please confirm that private sector firms are allowed to bid on this (the RFP has the box checked but later there is “tax exempt status” documentation required).

A1. Private Sector firms are allowed to submit an application. Those firms claiming to be a not-for-profit organization must submit the necessary document that exempts them from taxes.

Q2. Please confirm that discounts off of our standard rates will suffice for labor rates – or if there is a certain way this should be handled. We have DCAA-compliant indirect multipliers we can use but this often results in a higher labor rate because our multiplier is high.

A2. Please be advised that this award will be in the form of a grant and not a contract. Please contact the Office of Contracts and Procurement for further clarification on discounts for your standard rate.

Q3. From the work already done, is there a list of all residents within the study area, as well as a list of community leaders (church leaders, politicians, homeowner association chairs, etc.) – or does this need to be created? If it exists, may we see it for the proposal?
