Questions and Answers

Q1: What is the age range that the RFA is targeting?

A1: We are targeting people who are studying to be mechanics. This includes high school students and adults so long as they are enrolled in a program that is teaching them how to be mechanics. There is no upper age limit.

Q2: Does the grantee select the students that will be trained?

A2: DOEE has a list of technical programs that it has done outreach to, but it will likely be a mix of using that list and identifying programs on your own.

Q3: How many students do you have to reach?

A3: At least 200 students need to be reached.

Q4: It was mentioned that there were challenges with providing technical assistance, do you anticipate similar problem with this project?

A4: It is hard to anticipate because this is a new program, but DOEE anticipates this project being easier to implement. Many of the challenges the technical assistance side faced has had to do with shops' mistrust of government, competing priorities for shops' time, and convincing shops to change the habits, processes, and products that they may have been using for years.

Q5: Is there any limit on the number of students that need to be reached with the optional portion of this project?

A5: No. It is up to the applicant.
