Food Justice Definitions

Food Deserts

- Per the <u>USDA</u>, "A food desert is a low-income census tract where either a substantial number or share of residents has *low access to a supermarket or large grocery store.*"
- Low income means 20 percent or more of individuals are below the federal poverty line. A low-income census tract is any tract in which 33 percent of the population is over a mile from a grocery store in urban areas, or 10 miles in rural.

Food Apartheid

 This term recognizes the political, economic and social inequalities in the food system, rather than solely focusing on racial and geographical discrepancies.


Food Insecurity
