## Chapter 26 of Title 21 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations

## 2604 FEE SCHEDULES FOR DISTRICT WETLAND AND STREAM PERMIT AND WATER QUALITY CERTIFICATION APPLICATIONS

- Any person applying for a wetland and stream permit or water quality certification shall pay the fees described in this section.
- The Department shall adjust the fees in this section for inflation annually, using the Urban Consumer Price Index published by the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics. To perform this adjustment, the Department shall increase each fee by the percentage, if any, by which the Urban Consumer Price Index for June of the calendar year exceeds the Urban Consumer Price Index for June of the previous year. Each inflation adjustment shall be posted to the Department's website.
- An applicant for a permit, water quality certification, or modification of a permit or a water quality certification shall pay the appropriate nonrefundable application fee in Table 1 at the time the applicant submits the application to the Department.

An applicant for a permit, water quality certification, or modification of a permit or a water quality certification shall pay the appropriate supplemental fee in Table 2 after the Department has reviewed and commented on the application but prior to the issuance of the permit or certification.
