Take this form to a certified notary before you complete the rest. A notary is someone appointed by the government to witness people signing important documents. They will verify your identity and confirm that you are the person signing this document and that you aren't being pressured to sign.

You can find a notary in your neighborhood by visiting <https://os.dc.gov/service/search-notary-public>. The notary cannot charge you more than \$5 to notarize this document. Sometimes it will be free.
