## REQUIREMENTS

Any person, age 16 to 64, fishing in District of Columbia waters, including from the Virginia shoreline or National Park land, must possess a current DC Fishing License.

## **RESTRICTIONS**

- Striped bass (rockfish) season is from May 16 through December 31. Size and possession limits apply. Non-offset circle hooks required when targeting striped bass with bait.
- Cast and seine nets; intentional snagging; and the possession of American shad, hickory shad, & river herring is prohibited.

## **PENALTIES**

• Fishing licenses required for all anglers ages 16 to 64. Violation of regulated fishing activities may result in a fine ranging from \$50 to \$300 per infraction.

#### NOTE:

- A consumption advisory is in effect for all District waters.
- A Do Not Eat recommendation has been applied to the following species: American eel, common carp, and striped bass.
- The harvest of invasive blue catfish. flathead catfish, and northern snakehead, in accordance with all fishing regulations, is encouraged.
