Background

On January 16, 2019, Mayor Bowser signed legislation establishing the Lead Pipe Replacement Assistance Program (LPRAP) to assist District property owners to complete the replacement of lead pipes on their private property if the pipe in the public space is not lead.

- Quote for work from a licensed contractor (including the length of the pipe, the pipe material, and a picture of the point of entry).
- Household's most recent DC Water bill;
- Property owner's photo identification;
- Proof of property ownership; and
- Proof of income for each member of the household (if seeking approval for the income-eligible program).

Step 5: DOEE reviews your application

DOEE will review and approve or deny your application within 30 business days of the date on which you apply. If the quote from a licensed contractor exceeds a reasonable replacement cost, you may be denied or asked to submit a second quote for further consideration.

If approved: You will receive an email or letter with the details of your approval and your approval will be transmitted to DC Water. Work must be completed within ninety (90) days of approval or you must reapply for benefits.

If denied: You will receive an email or letter explaining why your request was denied. If you disagree with DOEE's decision, you may appeal the decision to the Director of DOEE.
