Objective

Restore the majority of Oxon Run and its associated wetlands, from Oxon Run National Parkway to Oxon Cove Park on the Potomac River.

Outputs


- Rehabilitation of 44 outfalls
- Restoration of approximately 20,000 linear feet of stream and associated wetland habitats
- Stabilization and revegetation of sloped uplands and riparian forest
- Reductions in nutrients and total suspended solids
