Resources to Maintain a Lead-Safe, Healthy, and Energy-Efficient Home

<u>Is Your Home Lead-Safe?</u> The District of Columbia's Lead-Hazard Prevention and Elimination Act requires property owners to ensure their pre-1978 residential property has no lead-based paint hazards. By law, non-intact paint in a pre-1978 property is a presumed lead-based paint hazard unless the owner has documentation proving the paint is not lead-based. Non-intact paint is also a housing code violation. The District requires owners to disclose lead hazards to potential renters and home buyers. A permit from the District's Department of Energy and Environment (DOEE) also may be required before renovating or abating a pre-1978 property.
