- Copy of a diploma or transcript verifying a degree in veterinary medicine, veterinary technology, or animal science; or
- A copy of a valid wildlife rehabilitation license or permit issued by another state.

Attach a copy of documentation of:

- 100 hours of hands on experience with wildlife in the last year;
- 12 hours of continuing education classes or research; and
- Membership in a nationally recognized rehabilitation association.

Attach documentation of the completion and passing of a course by the International Wildlife Rehabilitation Council or another approved organization.
