March 23rd 12pm-1pm Learn how to install a rain barrel! The District Department of Energy & Environment offers [rebates on rain barrels to DC residents](#). Rain barrels can capture rainwater and make it a usable resource, allowing it to seep back into the ground slowly and filter out pollutants, recharge the water table, and prevent stream erosion during heavy storms.
