Volunteer Guidelines

At Least Once Per Month (and before and after any rain event), You **SHOULD**:

- Remove sediment and debris from inlets, overflows, and curb lines
- Pick up trash
- Check for erosion
- Remove fallen leaves
- Monitor plant health
- Water during drought (periods of low rainfall)

With DOEE Approval, and Special Coordination and Training, You Can Also Help To:

- Remove weeds
- Prune (only during winter months when trees and shrubs are dormant, or when there is a sight-line or safety hazard)

- Illegal dumping

- Standing water longer than 72 hours
