✓ Environmental Policy/Sustainability Mission Statement

SiStained8 provides creative & custom educational lectures and composting equipment which are designed to encourage further interest and activities related to producing a quality compost product through the method of traditional composting in the District of Columbia.

✓ Annual Environmental Goals

SiStained8's mission is to increase compost education for DC area students, educators, government employees and food service workers then divert more than 4,000 pounds of food waste from local landfills for calendar 2024. This diversion will lead to the production of a quality soil amendment then in turn can be used to offset positive climate change progress (i.e. Urban Heat Islands) via the application to city soil.

SiStained8 successfully lead the first of its kind FREE community food waste drop-off program to support equitable and inclusive environmental activity for Ward 7 and Maryland residents in practicing traditional and hygienic compost management.
